IMPROVED SERVICES BETWEEN THE WEST LONDON LINE AND SOUTH LONDON IN THE MORNING AND EVENING PEAKS

From Monday 10 December 2007, the 0747 East Croydon - Kensington Olympia Mondays - Fridays service will also call at Thornton Heath, Norbury and Wandsworth Common, without increasing journey times. The new timings are:

This train will enable more West London Line commuters to travel to work without changing trains at Clapham Junction, as it provides convenient interchange at East Croydon, Selhurst and Balham.

For passengers travelling later in the morning peak, there are two shuttle services from Clapham Junction (Platform 17) to West Brompton and Kensington Olympia at 0843 and 0914. These were introduced in May.

In the evening peak on Mondays-Fridays, the 1729 Watford Junction - East Croydon service will be augmented by a new 1725 Kensington Olympia - East Croydon stopping service. The new timings are:

same-platform interchange for Streatham Hill, West Norwood, Gipsy Hill, Crystal Palace, Norwood Junction, West Croydon, Waddon, Wallington, Carshalton Beeches, Mitcham Junction, Hackbridge, Carshalton, Sutton and stations to Epsom and Epsom Downs;
plus interchange with the Northern Line.
